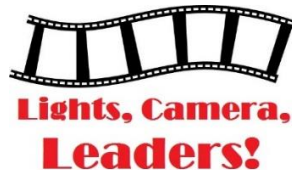
Winter Vacation 2017 Information

APPLICATION PERIOD

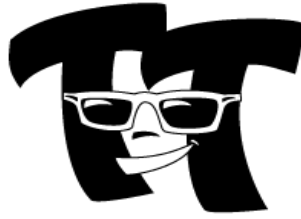
For students starting studies

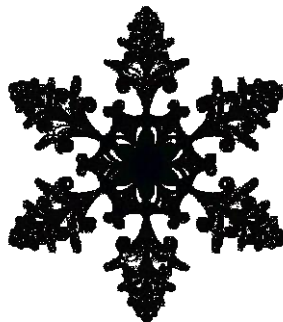
