Registration 2018 Dates . . .

Registration for **NEW** participants is ongoing.

Tomorrow's Topkids Child Care Society charges a one-time, non-refundable \$40 Application Fee to register in our programs or to go on a center waitlist.

Clubhouse September 2018

Registration for current participants will begin Monday, February 26th and ENDS Friday, March 9th. Forms will be distributed asking families if they will be returning in September 2018. New registrants will be accepted from our waitlists starting Monday, March 12th, 2018.

Spring Break Madness 2018

Registration begins Wednesday, February 7th, 2018

Summer Adventures 2018

Registration begins Tuesday, May 1st, 2018. For your registration to be processed, you must include an up to date photo and immunization records for your child. No exceptions.



Remember . . .

- For Summer Adventures we do not accept telephone registrations.
- Vacancies which occur after April 15th are difficult to fill. Therefore, June fees will be required if a family withdraws their child after this date. To secure a space for September the June payment is required.
- Taking a holiday? During the school year families must still pay the monthly fee to reserve the child's space for when they return.
- **ONE MONTH'S written notice or PAYMENT in lieu of notice is required to withdraw your child from the center or to change from full-time to part-time or drop-in care.**



Leaders Update . . .

This year we have **84** Leaders in total

The program's goals are to provide children in grades 4 and up with activity options that are stimulating and age appropriate. Every year we focus on a particular life skill and plan our activities around that skill.

As part of the "**Community and School Awareness**" component each Leader was expected to give a minimum of three (3) hours of their time performing good deeds for their school.

Our Leaders once again surpassed our expectations,
volunteering a combined total of 870 hours and 2 minutes!

Jennifer Zhang (Ferris) volunteered for 57 hours and 5 minutes;

Rachel Yu (McKinney) gave 56 hours and 3 minutes of her time for the betterment of her community; **Kobe Cam** (McKinney) stepped up to the challenge and volunteered for 53 hours and 31 minutes; next up was **Dominick Chen** (McKinney) with 37 hours and 45 minutes and **Mia Chen** (McKinney) with 25 hours and 1 minutes!



Junior Staff Update...

Junior Staff are children in grade 6 or 7 who had previously been part of and completed the Leaders program.

The program was started to give the older Leaders the opportunity to gain work experience and to learn about responsibility and commitment.

Our Junior Staff have been a great help in our centers committing to a minimum of 1 hour per week. They have been doing jobs ranging from leading the younger children in group games to helping keep our centers organized.

Tomorrow's Topkids logs the hours the Junior Staff person works and writes them a cheque based on the actual hours worked.


